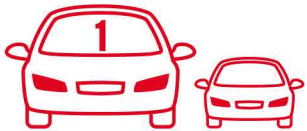


7 SIGNS OF A SAFE CAR

Physics dictates that larger and heavier cars are safer. Pay attention to the weight of the car to opt for greater safety.



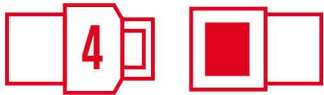
ON THE ROAD EXPERIENCE
